# Background

Planning Commission recommended approval with a proffer of a petition to rezone the property located at 2255 Jamestown Road from A, Agricultural Zoning, District to M-1, Light Industrial Zoning, District and 2262 County Drive from B-2, General Commercial Zoning, District to M-1, Light Industrial Zoning, District.



# Background (continued)

A request to appeal the Planning Commission decision on 2023-REZ-05 was submitted via email by Ray Ferguson of Poe Lane with support from Ann and Herman Burgess of Poe Lane on August 28<sup>th</sup>.

# Stated Basis for Appeal

The appeal is based on the following items as identified by the appellant:

- 1) Failure to submit the Williams Mullen 20-page document dated 07/10/2023 to the public prior to the Planning Commission meeting on August 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 2) Lack of input from Fort Gregg-Adams as required by Code of Virginia § 15.2-2211 and from Petersburg Public Schools.
- 3) No drawings as to how an 18-wheeler acceleration lane will look and impact HWY 460.

# Fort Gregg-Adams — VA State Code

§ 15.2-2211. Cooperation of local planning commissions and other agencies.

...The planning commission of any locality shall consult with the installation commander of any military installation that will be affected by potential development within the locality so as to reasonably protect the military installation against any adverse effects that might be caused by the development...




# 3) Details on the project's acceleration lane.
